We humbly request groups gather between fifteen to thirty of each item.

Guidelines/Helpful info for Hospitality bags

- Toiletries - full size is great
- Toothbrushes and toothpaste
- Razors
- Socks
- Moisturizer/Body lotion
- Hair ties
- Lipsticks, nail polish, lip gloss
- Hairbrushes/Combs
- Journal
- Haircare products

Reusable bag. Maybe something like this:

Drawstring Backpack Reusable Grocery Bags
Gift Bags Drawstring Backpack

Please, consider putting a card of encouragement in them, hearing encouragement from more people is immeasurable

Bonus items - extras for the Survivor Care Center and Blossom House

Journals & Pens

Hairbrushes/Combs

Back up t-shirts/stretchy pants in various sizes

Flip flops - \$2 flip flops are fine

Light blankets/bathrobes

Colored Pencils and adult coloring books

Play-dough

Fidget items

Some church groups also put Bibles or other faith based encouragements in the bags as well. This is not expected, but is allowed.
